Air Mauritius, the flag carrier of Mauritius will operate 5 weekly flights between Mumbai and Mauritius from

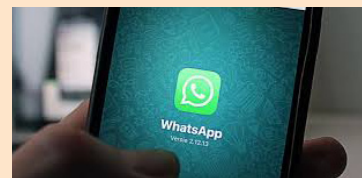


March 27. The airline said it is increasing the frequency of flights between the two cities. The announcement from

WTTC calls on EU to ease travel restrictions

The World Travel and Tourism Council (WTTC) has called the European Union Tourism Ministers to remove the remaining COVID-19 travel restrictions and to keep the economy open. WTTC was invited to address the EU Ministers on behalf of the private sector at a closed meeting held in Dijon. During this meeting, WTTC President and CEO Julia Simpson asked the ministers to lift the current restrictions that remain in place and help the travel and tourism recover, SchengenVisaInfo.com reports.

Even though Simpson addressed tourism ministers during this particular meeting, she said that now is the right time for France to make a difference during its EU presidency.



Italy to start lifting COVID related restrictions by March-end

Italy recently announced that it will gradually phase out its COVID-19 restrictions, and became the latest European country to relax pandemic-related measures.



As per the reports, the digital Green Pass needed to access public transportation or restaurants will not be required from May 1. As of now, the pass is issued to people who have either contracted COVID-19 and recovered, or are fully vaccinated.
